Problem

To enter BASIC from TRSDOS, if you type either BASIC -M:xxxxxx <ENTER> or BASIC -M:xxxxxx -F:x <ENTER> the machine hangs up. The malfunction will appear as though the computer is either trying to dump a section of RAM to the video or trying to LDIR something thru all of memory. The only corrective action is to re-boot.
