Solution

THIS MODULE WORKS FOR 3.0 AND PRIOR PROGRAMS.

1. Enter the following program in BASIC.

52000 CLS:TN=1:F=0
52100 PRINTTAB(20)"** FILE RECOVERY **"
52200 FORQ=0TOCP:V(Q,0)=0:V(Q,1)=0:NEXT
52300 PRINT@320,"** RECORD NUMBER : "TN
52400 J=TN:GOSUB1840:GOSUB1900:GOSUB1910
52500 IFE1$>CHR$(31)ANDE0$<CHR$(128)THEN5270
52600 F=F+1:V(TN,0)=-TN:V(TN,1)=-TN:GOTO5280
52700 PE=0:GOSUB3240:GOSUB5300:PE=1:GOSUB3240:GOSUB5300
52800 TN=TN+1:IFTN<CPTHEN5230ELSEN=TN-F-1
52900 GOSUB1790:CLOSE:GOSUB1740:J=1:GOSUB1840:GOTO210
53000 FORY=TN+1TOPTSTEP-1:V(Y,PE)=V(Y-1,PE):NEXT
53100 V(PT,PE)=TN:RETURN
```

2. SAVE the module by typing SAVE "RECOVER/ASC",A

3. Type: LOAD"MLS" and press <ENTER>

4. Type: MERGE"RECOVER/ASC" and press <ENTER>

5. Type: RUN and press <ENTER>

6. When the Mailing List menu appears, press the BREAK key.
7. When the screen shows "READY", type: GOTO 52000 and press ENTER.
8. The system will examine your data files and retrieve, re-sort and index all the valid data found. When this process is complete, the Mailing List Menu will appear. Press the @ key to exit the program immediately.
9. Make BACKUP copies of your "recovered" disks. Examine the data carefully before copying over your original disks. If the data is not correct, try the operation again.
