BACKUP will make a floppy disk unusable when a single drive backup is done. This is accomplished by, BACKUP $\emptyset \ \emptyset$ or similar method. The correct error messages are given but the disk is modified anyway.

The patches below will still give the correct error messages, but will prevent the disk from being modified.

Solution

1. At TRSDOS Ready, apply the following patches to correct the problem.
