Problem

There is a problem when the original master disk is run when you wish to re-unitialize the system or change the parameters.

Solution

If this problem occurs in the IMS system, the following must be done to clear out the system information. This should only be done in cases when there is not a clean master available.

- 1. At "TRSDOS Ready", type BASIC -F:3
- 2. When BASIC has loaded, enter the following program:
- 10 CLEAR 1000
- 20 KILL "SALEDATA/DAT": KILL "CONTROL/DAT"
- 3Ø OPEN"R",1,"CONTROL/DAT",96
- 40 FIELD1, 96 AS X\$:LSETX\$=STRING\$(96,32):PUT1,1
- 5Ø LSETX\$=STRING\$(96,Ø)
- 60 FORF=2TO5:PUT1,F:NEXTF:CLOSE
- 7Ø SYSTEM"IMS"
- Then type RUN and press <ENTER>
- 4. Type SYSTEM to get to TRSDOS READY and make a backup.
