Problem

- 1. After running MLSFIX, all items are sorted correctly, however numerous "garbage records appear at the end of the list.
- 2. The number of garbage records equals the user defined maximum minus actual records.

This problem occurs because file lengths are used to "reset" the number of records. Since the files are now pre-allocated, records may be inserted which were never used.

Solution

The problem is corrected by following the steps listed below.

- 1. Backup the diskette(s) and make the changes on the Backup copy of the program.
- 2. In BASIC load the program by typing LOAD"MLSFIX/BAS".
- 3. Make the following corrections:

ADDITIONS (Type then line followed by an <ENTER>)

1104 GOSUB 650:N=N+1:TN=TN+1:EL\$=E1\$:IW=1

- 4. Type SAVE"MLSFIX/BAS" to save the changes in the program.
- 5. At TRSDOS Ready, make a backup copy of the corrected diskette.
