## **Problem**

When more segments have been created than was desired, the number of segments can be reduced by the following steps.

## **Solution**

- 1. On a backup of the Profiles master diskette create a file by defining data segments exactly as you want them to be.
- 2. Expand to the same size as the original file.
- 3. Swap diskettes and using the kill command (in TRSDOS) KILL all segments not wanted or needed.
- 4. Copy the \*\*\*/MAP file from the new diskette to the original diskette.
- 5. Copy the files that were killed in step 3 from the new diskette to the original diskette.
