### Problem

The end-of-memory test will take too long, due to large buffer accessed, to determine the end-of-memory test.

The following problems would occur: illegal instruction traps, illegal SVC, loss of memory and faulty memory errors. These errors were more prevalent on machines with 256K or more memory.

### Solution

To force the high end-of-memory test to use a 2 byte buffer instead of 1K bytes for comparison, apply the following patches at TRSDOS Ready.
