## **Problem**

In some unattended modes of operation, it is desirable to have HOST start up without prompting the operator to enable or disable the remote  $\langle BREAK \rangle$  key. Listed below are some optional patches to TRSDOS 4.1 which, when applied, will allow the HOST function to start up without displaying the "Disable remote  $\langle BREAK \rangle$  key (Y/N)" or requiring the operator's reply.

## Solution

When the first patch is applied, the remote <BREAK> is automatically enabled at start up. If the second patch is applied instead of the first, HOST starts with the remote <BREAK> key disabled.

To enable the remote <BREAK> key:

PATCH SYSTEM/SYS R=110 B=213 F=2158F50E C=06001818

To disable the remote <BREAK> key:

PATCH SYSTEM/SYS R=110 B=213 F=2158F50E C=06011818

The above patches are for the 64K HOST.
