Installation Instructions

There are two main applications on your **Information Resources** 6/96 CD: Information Navigator and PatchFinder. PatchFinder must be installed on your disk drive. Information Navigator can be installed on your disk drive or to conserve disk space, viewed directly from your CD. Please read the following information for an installation overview.

Installing Supportfolio-Information Resources 6/96

Installing the entire **Information Resources** CD on your disk drive requires the following:

- a system running the IRIX 6.2 or 5.3 operating system
- 71MB of available disk space

NOTE: if you do not have enough available disk space, you can view Information Navigator directly from the CD-ROM and choose to install PatchFinder only. See the instructions below.

To install, insert the CD labeled "Supportfolio-Information Resources 6/96" into the CD-ROM drive and take the following steps from your desktop:

Select "Software Manager" from the system toolchest. Once it displays, enter the following in the "Available Software" field:

/CDROM/dist/lib_62

(to install on IRIX 6.2)

or /CDROM/dist/lib_53

(to install on IRIX 5.3)

Click on on the button that reads, "Install Automatically," then click on the button that reads, "Start." Software Manager will notify you when installation is complete.

To View Information Navigator from CD

If you do not have enough available disk space to install the "Supportfolio – Information Resources CD", you can access Information Navigator directly from the CD-ROM. Insert the CD labeled "Supportfolio-Information Resources CD" into the CD-ROM player. Double-click on the CD-ROM icon on your desktop. Once the window opens, double-click on the "CDstartme" icon inside. Information Navigator will take a few minutes to load.

If you are viewing Information Navigator from CD, the following instructions will tell you how to install PatchFinder ONLY from the "Supportfolio-Information Resources 6/96 CD".

Installing PatchFinder Only

PatchFinder requires the following:

- a system running the IRIX 6.2 or 5.3 operating system
- 5MB of available disk space

Insert the CD labeled "Supportfolio-Information Resources 6/96" into the CD-ROM player. Select "Software Manager" from the system toolchest on your desktop. Once the Software Manager interface is displayed, enter the following in the "Available Software" field:

```
/CDROM/dist/lib_62 (to install on IRIX 6.2) or /CDROM/dist/lib_53 (to install on IRIX 5.3)
```

Click on on the button that reads, "Customize Installation," then select the following for installation:

PatchFinder Client Software, Release 1.0

Patch Server, Release 1.0

ES Auto Update Software, Release 2.0

Then click the button labeled "Start." Software Manager will notify you when installation is complete.

Configuration Instructions

To Access Patches via the Internet

Determine if you have direct Internet access by taking the following steps in a shell:

/usr/etc/ping patches.sgi.com

You should see results like this:

chkconfig patchsvr on (to turn the patch server on automatically upon reboot)

/usr/sbin/patchsvr -i

To Access Patches from the IRIX Patches CD

Insert the IRIX Patches 6/96 CD into the CD-ROM drive, and type:

% su

chkconfig patchsvr on (to turn the patch server on)

/usr/sbin/patchsvr -l /CDROM &

Launch Instructions

To launch Information Navigator, take the following steps:

- 1. Select "An Icon" from the Find toolchest.
- 2. Type "infonav" (lowercase) in the test field provided.
- 3. Double-click the infonav icon that appears.

(Information Navigator may take a few minutes to load.)

4. Drag the icon onto the desktop for future use.

To launch PatchFinder, take the following steps:

- 1. Select "An Icon" from the Find toolchest.
- 2. Type "patchfinder" (lowercase) in the test field provided.
- 3. Double-click the patchfinder icon that appears.
- 5. Drag the icon onto the desktop for future use.

Viewing On-Line Release Notes

To view release notes from a graphics terminal, place the CD in the CD-ROM drive, open a UNIX® shell, and type:

/CDROM/CDgrelnotes (for graphics terminals)

or

/CDROM/CDrelnotes (for non-graphics terminals)

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
