Introduction

This reference card is designed to briefly describe and aid you in determining which ViaNet® commands and options are available to you. For more information about the commands and options, refer to the ViaNet Intermediate User's Reference.

Command Formats & Explanations

- / Slashes precede switch options in the command line.
- [] Square brackets indicate the enclosed entry is optional.
- When a bar separates items, only one of the separated options may be chosen.
- /V May be used with any command to display its version number. When used with the VIANET command, however, you must be in the NETSYS directory.

filespec The full path name and file name for a given file.

ViaNet Commands

ACCESS [username]

Log onto the network, or if ACCESS is entered alone, access information is displayed

LOGOFF

Log off the network

MACASGN [/D]

macname [macstring] @[filespec] [/S] PRN [macstring] [/S]

Define name substitutions
